

MoU with National Digital Library of India (NDLI)



DECLARATION OF COLLABORATION

Nirwan University Jaipur hereinafter referred to as NUJ and having its registered address as Near Bassi-Rajadhok Toll, Agra Road, Jaipur -303305 Rajasthan, founded in the year 2017 by Govt. of Rajasthan.

AND

National Digital Library of India (NDLI), a project established under Ministry of Education (MoE), Govt. of India, under its National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (NMEICT), and carried out by Indian Institute of Technology Kharagpur, located at Kharagpur - 721302, West Bengal

have a shared vision to facilitate and encourage creation, collaboration and dissemination of knowledge among people, especially but not limited to the student community, youth and life-long learners of the country, and have identified synergies between the two that can help meet common objectives and help nurture literary thoughts, creativity across the country and world.

The two parties on 03.01.2024 agree to collaborate in the long term to complement activities of each other to realize their shared vision. Hence a Declaration of Collaboration is being signed.

The activities that may be undertaken as part of this collaboration are:

- 1) NUJ will seek to promote reading, research, and the spirit of enquiry among the students, academic teams and management of the institutions, in collaboration with NDLI, to bring the best reading and research resources to its team.
- 2) NUJ will ensure that all the institutions under its umbrella become part of the NDLI Initiative.
- 3) NUJ and NDLI will work together to promote the literacy, reading and research among the underserved population of India, with a special focus on the girl child.
- 4) NDLI will facilitate setting up and running of NDLI Clubs in schools and colleges under the NUJ
- 5) NDLI may include copyright free contents (free & open) of NUJ in the NDLI repository for wider dissemination of these contents
- 6) Publicize the NDLI through NUJ network and advocate its use to a wide range of stakeholder groups and forums
- 7) NUJ will announce the collaboration with NDLI on its website.

The scope of this Collaboration may be extended/ modified by mutual consent of both the parties.

In general, cost involved, if any, to undertake activities covered by this collaboration in the NUJ end will be borne by NUJ and that in the NDLI end will be borne by NDLI, unless otherwise decided jointly. The activities shall not create any sort of contractual or financial obligations between the two parties.

This is a voluntary collaboration and does not legally bind any of the parties to each other in any manner. The collaboration may be ceased by either party by way of an e-mail or letter addressed to the other party, with advance notice of at least one month. However, all content shared between the two entities will remain shared even after termination. Any disputes shall be mutually resolved.
